### **One Stop Compliance: QMessage Monitor Brings Critical PCI Compliance to Love's Travel Stops and Country Stores**

**May 21, 2008** – QMessage Monitor, the IBM System i message monitoring solution from CCSS has been selected by Love's Travel Stops and Country Stores to help the company comply with PCI DSS (Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard.) Operating from more than 210 travel stop locations across 33 states from California to Virginia, each Love's location includes a convenience store, a gift shop, a fast food restaurant and gasoline and diesel dispensers for cars, trucks and RV's and has become the first name in road side fuel and food services since 1964. Today, the company generates over \$7 billion in sales and sustains a growth rate of 15 new locations a year.

Love's processes hundreds of thousands of payment card transactions each year and required an effective way to monitor for PCI compliance. PCI DSS was developed by the major credit card companies as a guideline to help organizations that process card payments. It aims to prevent credit card fraud, cracking and various other security vulnerabilities and threats. A company processing, storing, or transmitting payment card data must be PCI DSS compliant or risk losing their ability to process credit card payments and being audited and/or fined. Love's Travel Stops and Country Stores required a simple means of ensuring their systems complied with this standard and offered them an easy means of recording and reporting each transaction for PCI auditors.
